



S. Daniel Abraham Israel Program

For the benefit of those students who wish to spend a year of study in Israel with a concentration in Jewish studies, Yeshiva University, with the approval of the New York State Education Department and the government of Israel, has established the S. Daniel Abraham Israel Program. Under this program, students may take courses for credit at the university at any one of more than 40 Israeli institutions. A current list of such institutions and the application form for the program is available upon request from the Office of Admissions and online at <http://yu.edu/israel-program/>. Students must be accepted by Yeshiva University as well as a participating Israeli institution in order to be enrolled in the Israel Program.

The Israel Program enables students to:

- Incorporate study at Israeli yeshivot, women's seminaries, or universities into their college years, enhancing their Yeshiva University experience
- Immerse themselves in the land, people, history, and culture

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Yeshiva University's Israel representatives visit schools regularly and offer comprehensive services including academic guidance, career planning and personal counseling. All facets of the admissions process may be addressed by our Israel staff as well, culminating with on-site Israel registration for the next semester's classes at Yeshiva. In addition, the program sponsors lectures and activities where students can gather under the auspices of Yeshiva University, and a guidance center to provide support to help ease the occasionally challenging adjustment to a year's study in Israel. Yeshiva University also sponsors major academic and cultural events for American students in Israel, such as concerts, Melavah Malkas, Honors Events, an Inter-Seminary Choir Competition, art and photo competitions, an annual career fair and weekly D'var Torah News Letters.
